

STOP SEXUAL HARASSMENT AND SEXUAL ABUSE

The Escondido Police Department has a zero-tolerance policy for all forms of sexual conduct, including sexual harassment between clients, staff, volunteers, contractors, visitors, and inmates. This zero-tolerance policy applies to all facilities and programs that provide services to clients under the jurisdiction of the Escondido Police Department. If you suspect sexual abuse, please report it to a facility staff member. The Escondido Police will investigate all allegations of sexual misconduct.

What should you do if you know someone is being or has been sexually abused, sexually harassed, or sexually assaulted while in custody?

- Report the incident to an Escondido PD staff member. Call 760-839-4722
- Ask to speak with a supervisor.
- File a complaint or report. [Citizen Complaint](#) or call 760-839-4722
- Call one of the abuse and neglect hotlines listed below.

You do not have to name the individual who sexually abused, harassed, or assaulted a victim to receive assistance. However, providing specific information can help staff assist you more effectively. If you or someone you know has been sexually assaulted, medical services are available.
